Accessible Parking Services

All Airport parking facilities have convenient parking for vehicles displaying a:

- DP (Disabled Person) license plate
- DV (Disabled Veteran) license plate
- Disabled Parking placard

The Domestic Garage has standard parking at all levels. Van accessible parking is available through [ParkLink2U](#) on Level 4 Departures near Terminal 1, Boarding Area C.

International Garages A and B have standard and van accessible parking at all levels.

In Long Term Parking, accessible parking spaces for standard and van accessible vehicles are located on the first (ground) floor. DP's Long Term Parking shuttle buses are wheelchair accessible.
